PERMIT TO PURCHASE CERTAIN
UTILITY SERVICES WITHOUT THE
PAYMENT TO THE VENDOR OF THE
UTILITY TAX

Pursuant to Sales and Use Tax Rule 810-6-5-.26.02, WESTPOINT HOME, INC. whose principal place of business in Alabama is located in Valley, Opelika, etc. and who is engaged in manufacturing textiles, is hereby permitted, effective on and after August 8, 2005 to purchase electricity from Alabama Power Company, natural gas from Alabama Gas Corporation, and water from Chattahoochee Valley Water District without the payment to the vendor of the utility privilege license tax upon or with respect thereto, subject to the following conditions, viz:

(a) The holder of this permit shall report such utility privilege license tax as specified by the Department, and shall pay said tax directly to the State Department of Revenue, said tax to be reported and paid monthly, on or before the 20th day of the month, for purchases of electricity from Alabama Power Company, natural gas from Alabama Gas Corporation, and water from Chattahoochee Valley Water District made during the next preceding calendar month.

(b) The holder of this permit shall be required to keep such books and records as may be necessary to determine such tax liability, such records shall be subject to examination by the Department.

(c) Upon demand of the Department, the holder of this permit shall execute a bond or indemnity agreement securing the payment of such taxes to the Department, in an amount not exceeding six months' estimated utility tax liability.

(d) This permit shall not be transferable, and may be cancelled by the Department upon notice by registered mail to the holder thereof.

This permit is issued pursuant to said regulation, application therefor filed by WESTPOINT HOME, INC. on August 23, 2005 and order entered by the Department on September 1, 2005 approving such application.
